- This is slated to happen on Thursday, Oct. 31, 2024, after which pediatric intensive care services will no longer be offered at HonorHealth Scottsdale Shea Medical Center. **We will continue to offer general pediatric inpatient hospital care at this location.**
- We remain committed to serving our community and providing exceptional, high-quality maternity and pediatric care.
- HonorHealth Scottsdale Shea Medical Center will continue to offer maternity and inpatient pediatric hospital care to our community, including high-risk obstetrics, in-house OB hospitalists, emergency services, eight licensed pediatric beds, robust post-delivery resources and a Level III NICU, which offers advanced care for newborns of any gestational age.
- HonorHealth Scottsdale Shea Medical Center will still offer care that's focused on providing our patients and their families a kid-friendly environment with an expert team that includes child life specialists, pediatric hospitalists and pediatric-trained nurses and physicians.
- Children will continue to have access to general pediatric treatments, including but not limited to, for respiratory issues including asthma, sepsis, and scorpion and snake bites.
